I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, hereby release and hold harmless and agree not to sue The Equestrian Federation of Australia and/or the event organizer, their officers, officials, volunteers, coaches, agents and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, state bodies, affiliated clubs and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the activities (all of whom are referred to as "Releasees") with respect to any and all injury, disability, death, or loss of damage to person or property, whether caused by the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise.

Show Hunter Hack

- The horse is expected to demonstrate the ability to provide a smooth, even ride and reliable temperament.
- The horse should exhibit sound conformation, be free from hereditary defects and unsoundness. It should demonstrate that it is sound in wind and limb but as it is expected to be suitable to carry its rider across country over a variety of terrain and obstacles, an honorable bump or lump can be overlooked.
- The Show Hunters compete on the flat only and do not need to prove they can jump. The work-out should be similar to that expected in an open hack class but should always include a gallop. It must cover the ground in all paces, with the gallop being well balanced and moving from the shoulders, with the hind legs well under. A flat and stilted action is unacceptable.
- Manners are extremely important and all misdemeanors should be penalized.
- Saddlery should be clean, neat and well-fitting but may be more workmanlike than normal for an open hack class. Brow bands should be plain and not ribboned. Biting is optional.
- Preference given to conservative colours i.e. tweed or dark jackets.

Bridle Path Hack

- To be judged 70% Performance and Manners, 20% Condition and Confirmation, and 10% Appointments and Presentation.
- Horse should move with a round outline, hindquarter well under to achieve plenty of impulsion. Horses to be shown at the walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. At the judges option exhibitors may be asked to lengthen any gait, but only the top eight horses may be asked to gallop. At the hand gallop the judge may ask the class to halt and stand quietly on a loose rein. Horses may be asked to reverse direction at the walk and trot only. The turn is made toward the centre of the ring. Riders shall not be required to dismount. The judge may require the horse to rein back, but at his discretion only with the finalists. Class is judged entirely on the circle. Light contact with the horses mouth is to be recommended.
- Appointments : English riding coat, breeches (jodhpurs) long boots. Approved safety helmet. Shirt with tie or stock. Ratcatcher permitted for ladies. Gloves optional but preferred. Preference given to conservative colours.
- Optional – English type spurs, rowelled or dummy, stock or tie pin, hacking cane with or without flapper, whip maximum length 2 ft.
- Tack – English saddle, show or forward seat type, leather, cord or linen girths, regulation snaffle, Pelham or bit and bradoon, all with cavesson nosebands. Noseband loose enough to allow 4 fingers to be inserted between the nose and the leather.

AWHA NSW Branch Gala Weekend – Rules and Conditions of Entry

General Rules

- **ASA approved safety helmet must be worn at all times when riding, including the warm up area.**
- Entries should be mailed, with cheque or money order (no cash) made out to “AWHA Ltd”, copy of horse/s’ registration papers, profile and completed entry forms to “Show Secretary” AWhA, P.O. Box 418, Picton, NSW, 2571. Ph: 0246 596231. Note that stable bond should be paid with a separate cheque.
- Age of horses to be calculated from August 1st. Any horse foaled before 1st August, in any year, shall be deemed to be one year old on that date (except horses foaled in the Northern Hemisphere)
- Insurance Levy: All exhibitors must be current members of AWhA or EFA or pay \$20.00 insurance levy.
- ALL Adult participants and/or parent or guardian of junior handler or junior rider must sign Release/Waiver form.
- Notice to all competitors: the welfare of the horse is paramount.
- Neither the organisers nor the owner of the property accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, or any other persons or property whatsoever.
- Lunging is allowed only in the lunge rings near the stable complex. One horse to be lunged in a ring at any time.
- A safety sheet will be sent to exhibitors and each competitor, groom etc must read and comply with those safety requirements.
- Dogs are permitted on the grounds and must be on a leash at all times.
- Time schedule will be provided before the Show to each participant: Committee will endeavour to run all events on time, however no class will start before the allotted time and **no class will be held for late arrivals or handlers committed in other rings.**

Led and Ridden Classes Rules

- The competition will be held in accordance with the rules set by the AWhA. The AWhA reserves the right to vary any aspect of the program as required. The judges’ decision is final.
- Entry Fees: AWhA Members: \$18 first class entered, \$13 each additional class entered; Non Members: \$25 first class entered, \$20 each additional class entered
- Entries will be accepted as valid if received by the closing date which is 7th August 2009 and complete with all details as per Checklist on this entry form.
- Entries received after closing date will be accepted at the discretion of the Committee and if accepted will incur an additional \$10.00 per class. Entries to additional classes on the day will be considered by the committee.
- Scratchings will be accepted until 9pm on the 7th August 2009, a refund of entry fees after that date will not be made.
- Junior Handler rules and guidelines will be provided to participants with time schedule prior to the Show.
- All colts/stallions 2 years and over must be led with a bridle and bit. Foals must be led including foals at foot.
- Bridle Numbers must be collected from Stables Manager on the day (located in Riders Mess). \$10.00 refundable deposit per exhibit to be paid with entries. Each exhibit must wear 2 numbers, and have the correct number before entering the marshalling area. If Bridle numbers are defaced, altered or damaged the deposit will not be refunded.
- Horses are to be presented in the marshalling area (Warm-up arena opposite the entry to the Indoor Arena) prior to the class time stipulated on the program, with bridle numbers in place. Failure to report to the Marshall at the allotted time may result in automatic elimination.
- Championships: Champions will be judged on or as soon as possible after the published time. All eligible first prizewinners must parade for relevant Championships or forfeit prizes. If Champion is found to be ineligible for class, then the Reserve Champion will be awarded Champion. Those eligible to compete for Reserve Champion (the horse placed 2nd to the Champion in its class) must Marshall 5 minutes prior to Champion judging times so they are ready to contest as soon as the Champion is awarded.
- Prizes: Prize Vouchers will be handed to winners with ribbons where applicable and these vouchers must be presented at Secretary’s Office to claim prize. Prizes not collected on the day will be forfeited.
