



All competitors and assistants must have completed the applicable acknowledgement or waiver and paid the associated fee (if applicable). **No wrist band, no entry to the marshalling area**. Strictly no spectators are permitted in the marshalling area.
- 5. AWHA QLD Branch Horse Health Declarations must be completed and signed on the day. Please ensure you bring this with you and hand in to the office on your arrival.
- 6. Neither the organisers nor the owner of the property accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, or any other persons or property whatsoever.
- 7. Dogs are not permitted on the grounds.
- 8. All colts and stallions 2 years old and over must be led with a bridle and bit. All stallions must comply with the EA Stallion Safe Practices Guidelines.
- 9. All foals with or without the mare must be haltered and led.
- 10. ASA approved safety helmets must be worn at all times when riding, including in the warm-up area.
- 11. Notice to all competitors: the welfare of the horse is paramount.
- 12. If you do not seek your stable bond prior to departure from Gatton Showgrounds, it will be used to pay for cleaning or, in the case of clean stables it will be considered as a donation. No bonds will be refunded after the show weekend.
- 13. A professional photographer (Catherine Reid of Catherine Reid Photography and Designs) will be present on the day. The photographic area will be located on the northern end of the stable complex. When Catherine is not photographing in the indoor arena, please make your way over to this area to have your horse's photograph taken. 

Led Class Rules

- 1. Each led class has been allocated 10 minutes. If less time is required, the following classes may be called early.
- 2. The competition will be held in accordance with the rules set by the AWHA Ltd. The AWHA Ltd reserves the right to vary any aspect of the program as required.
- 3. Presented horses must be in good health and must not be lame.
- 4. The judges' decision is final.
- 5. Horse number: each horse will be supplied a number. A \$10 bond per number is required to be pre-paid with your entry. The bond will be refunded to you at the show when the number is handed in.
- 6. Horses are to be presented in the marshalling area 10 minutes prior to the time stipulated on the program. Failure to report to the marshall at the allotted time may result in automatic elimination. No class will be delayed for late comers. **Horse handler and stewards only in marshalling area**.
- 7. Championship: Champions will be judged on or as soon as possible after the completion of the led classes. All eligible first prize winners must parade for relevant Championships or forfeit prizes. If the Champion is found to be ineligible for the class, then the Reserve Champion will be awarded Champion. Those eligible to compete for Reserve Champion (the horse placed 2nd to the Champion in its class) must marshall 5 minutes prior to Champion judging times so they are ready to contest as soon as the Champion is awarded.
- 8. All horses 2 years of age and over are expected to be capable of leading without outside assistance. You may have assistance for yearlings and foals alone or with their dams. Excessive stimulation of any exhibit will not be tolerated.

The protocol for AWHA and Open Warmblood Led classes is as follows:

- 1. All exhibits are to enter the ring together led in at walk and presented to the judges, with the near side facing in the designated area to be scored for type and conformation.
- 2. Upon completion of the type and conformation assessment, all exhibits are to return to the collecting area as directed by the judges.
- 3. At the judges' indication, each exhibit will individually re-present to the judges and when asked to move off, commence one circuit of the exhibition triangle (see diagram on page 10) in walk, followed by a second circuit in trot. *Please note*: the triangle is used to demonstrate your horse's ability to move straight and to show correct movement. This is what the judges wish to see. It is to your advantage to follow these directions.
- 4. After presentation all exhibits are to remain in close proximity to the judging area as directed by the judges.
- 5. At the completion of the last exhibit the judges will announce the place getters.

The Exhibition Triangle.



Your inspection will take place on a triangular course where you place the left side of your horse to face the judges. Here the so-called open position is obligatory.

The judges will score the individual marks for conformation and then ask you to walk away from them on the triangle, turning around the markers in a clockwise direction and return to your original starting position. Your horse should walk freely forward and straight, on a reasonably loose rein. Remember to look forward in the direction you are walking, not at your horse.

You will then be asked to trot one lap with your horse in a clockwise direction. The judges stay at the same place, and with the triangular form of the course they are able to first inspect your horse from behind, then its action deployment from the side, and finally its correctness from the front. For that reason, however, it is necessary to follow exactly the triangular form of the course.

At the trot the horse should be given the chance to move as freely as possible. With regard to very actively moving the horse the handler should be someone who is able to move well enough him/herself to show this movement. When trotting your horse you take both the reins in your right hand.

After the trotted lap return your horse to the judges from the right side standing. Judges may allow a second trot triangle in order to see movement. If on the day you do not understand what is requested of you, please seek clarification.

Please note: all horses 2 years of age and over are expected to be capable of leading without outside assistance. You may have assistance for yearlings and foals alone or with their dams. Excessive stimulation of any exhibit will not be tolerated.

Hillenvale Park Performance Warmbloods is owned and operated by Lisette New-Sippel. A boutique Holstein Warmblood stud originally from Rockhampton in Central Queensland.

I transferred to the Lockyer Valley in 2001 to complete a Diploma of Applied Science (Equine Studies). Prior to relocating we travelled the Agricultural Show circuit campaigning Thoroughbreds. With extensive hacking experience it was at a regional show that I first saw the Holstein Warmblood. We acquired a filly from River Range Warmblood Stud which was campaigned in dressage and hacking until semi-retirement to stud.

River Range Independence (Northern Classic x Flaneur (Imp)) is our foundation broodmare and has produced two beautiful colts thus far, HVP Saba's Eclipse by Noblewood Park Cougar (Collins x Caletto II) and HVP Courage by Noblewood Park Casino Royale (Imp) (Casall La Silla x Levantos I).

COUGAR, at an unprecedented six months old, won Supreme Champion at the Holsteiner Classifications in February 2002, was the winner of the 4 year old WA State Dressage Young Horse Championships in 2005, the Bates Newcomer Award in 2007, the 2010 ISS Summer Classic CSI-W Futurity and the 2010 NSW Country Jumping Championship - currently being campaigned by Georgina Oakman in eventing.

CASINO ROYALE is the first stallion to be imported into Australia that is by the popular and very gifted German Holstein sire, Casall La Silla. NP Casino Royale is successfully campaigned by Vicki Roycroft.



Our stud is expecting another Casino Royale foal in November this year. I prefer the performance bloodlines as it gives youngsters a great start in any discipline. We only breed one or two foals a year and are currently looking to selectively expand our broodmare band.

Our focus is on nutrition, education and overall wellbeing – a happy horse is a healthy horse.





The protocol for AWHA and Open Ridden Warmblood classes is as follows:

- 1. One rider per horse is permitted. There will be NO change of rider before the event.
- 2. Each ridden class has been allocated 15 minutes. If less time is required, the following classes may be called early.
- 3. The competition will be held in accordance with the rules set by the AWHA Ltd. The AWHA Ltd reserves the right to vary any aspect of the program as required.
- 4. Presented horses must be in good health and must not be lame.
- 5. The judges' decision is final.
- 6. Horse number: each horse will be supplied a number. A \$10 bond per number is required to be pre-paid with your entry. The bond will be refunded to you at the show when the number is handed in.
- 7. Horses are to be presented in the marshalling area 10 minutes prior to the time stipulated on the program. Failure to report to the marshall at the allotted time may result in automatic elimination. No class will be delayed for late comers. **Horse riders and stewards only in marshalling area**.
- 8. Championship: Champions will be judged on or as soon as possible after the completion of the ridden classes. All eligible first prize winners must parade for relevant Championships or forfeit prizes. If the Champion is found to be ineligible for the class, then the Reserve Champion will be awarded Champion. Those eligible to compete for Reserve Champion (the horse placed 2nd to the Champion in its class) must marshall 5 minutes prior to Champion judging times so they are ready to contest as soon as the Champion is awarded.
- 9. Exhibits are to enter the ring at a walk in a clockwise direction at the discretion of the ring steward/judges and may be asked to trot and canter as a group.
- 10. All exhibits will leave the arena and return individually when called. Changes of gait and direction, or a simple age appropriate workout will be indicated by the ring steward/judges.
- 11. At the completion of the last exhibit the judges will announce the place getters.
- 12. All exhibits in ridden classes must be ridden in a snaffle bridle. Use of side saddles and martingales is prohibited. Spurs must comply with EA guidelines.
- 13. ASA approved safety helmets must be worn at all times when riding, including in the warm-up area.

Jaybee Alto is a 5 year old chestnut stallion standing at 16.2 hh. He is by Alabaster (GER) out of Jaybee Desiree by Don Schufro (GER) out of Gloria (Imp), a full imported pedigree. He is the best moving and conformed young stallion Jaybee Farm has had, and at Jaybee Farm, that is a big statement. He has been classified and is approved by the AWHA Ltd. Jaybee Alto is the seventh colt they have presented for classification, and the seventh colt that has been passed and approved.

Jaybee Alto is a 3/4 brother to World Equestrian Games Australian Representative and Sydney CDI*** 2011 Big Tour Winner Jaybee Alabaster (IIU/Geld) (Alabaster x Glorieux x Grundstein I). - * The semen will be free of charge, but the mare owner will pay for transport from Agnes Banks Equine Clinic, Agnes Banks, NSW, and the veterinary costs involved in inseminating their mare.
- * 3 attempts are allowed to achieve one pregnancy.

Jaybee Farm will take a few outside mares to him this year by transported chilled semen or frozen semen. His stud fee is \$2,200.00 AUD inc. GST.
