Auction Terms and Conditions

All stallions featured in the AWHA QLD Branch 2014 Online Stallion Service Auction have an active AWHA Ltd breeding permit, i.e. are Approved, Licensed, Performance Accepted, Imported Frozen Semen (IFS) listed or Imported Chilled Semen (ICS) listed. All stallion owners will accept AWHA Ltd classified Warmblood Studbook and Warmblood, Thoroughbred or Anglo Arabian Foundation Mares.

Owners with mares outside of these categories are advised to contact the stallion owner/frozen semen distributor to obtain their standard breeding contract and terms and conditions (if not supplied on the stallion's Horsezone auction web page) to ensure their mare is accepted by the stallion owner/frozen semen distributor.

By bidding on stallion services in the AWHA QLD Branch 2014 Online Stallion Service Auction, you are stating that you have read, understood and agree to all auction terms and conditions. If you do not understand or agree with the terms and conditions listed herein, or the stallion owner's/agent's breeding contract and special terms and conditions, or with Horsezone's terms and conditions, do not place any bids as no refunds will be provided. Please note: read ALL terms and conditions carefully!

1. The official opening date for this auction is Friday 15th August 2014 at noon, remaining open for a two week duration. Bidding closes at 8:00 pm Australian EST on 29th August 2014. You must be able to form legally binding contracts to use this service. This means that if you are under 18 years of age or otherwise legally prohibited from entering into binding contracts, you must not use this service.

- 2. All stallion services are listed in AUD inclusive of GST and all bids will be considered as inclusive of GST. Please note: this auction is open only to people with mares currently in Australia available for breeding during the 2014 breeding season.
- 3. You agree to make your own investigations in the stallion service auction prior to bidding, ensuring that you are fully aware of those special conditions and additional costs. Please note: final acceptance of mares at stud is a matter for you, the bidder, and the stallion owner/frozen semen distributor. Prospective bidders are advised to contact the stud and obtain their standard breeding contract and terms and conditions (if not supplied on the stallion's Horsezone auction web page). The following general guidelines are offered:
 - a. The stud has the right to accept or reject any mare, and
- b. Unless other arrangements are made between the stud and the successful bidder, mares must arrive at the stud or be ready for Al no later than 31 Dec 14. No mare receiving a service won through this auction will be served after the end of 28 Feb 15.
- 4. You understand that you will be bidding only on the actual stallion service and that there may be additional costs associated with the stallion service such as booking and/or handling fees, collection costs, shipment costs, agistment, veterinary costs, etc. which are outlined in the stallions' breeding contracts and special terms and conditions.
- 5. When you register for this service, you must choose your user name and password. You must have a valid user name (or "login") and password before you can bid on a service on Horsezone. You are responsible for the security of your user name and password. You authorise us to assume that anyone using your user name and password is you or someone authorised by you. Unauthorised access and use of your details will, under no circumstances, negate your liability for any bids made on Horsezone or any obligation to purchase a stallion service

which may result from such use. You must notify Horsezone immediately if you become aware of any unauthorised use of your user name or password or of any other security breach.

- 6. You agree that you will not, in registering for and using the service, use a false or misleading name or give false or misleading information. You must ensure that your information is true, accurate and complete, and not fraudulent or misleading.
- 7. When you use this service and bid on an online auction conducted on Horsezone, you are making an offer to buy the service at your bid price. If your bid price is the winning bid amount, you will be the winning bidder and are obliged to purchase the service you have bid for and pay the winner's bid amount plus any additional charges that you may be obliged to pay. Please take care when making a bid as once your bid is placed it cannot be withdrawn. Please take care when setting an autobid, as once your autobid is placed it cannot be altered or withdrawn.
- 8. The AWHA QLD Branch and Horsezone are not responsible for bids not received, processed or accepted due to technical difficulties, including those online bids placed by autobid. In particular, we are not responsible for any loss, liability or damage incurred by you as a result of a bid not received, processed or accepted due to technical difficulties.
- 9. We do not guarantee continuous, uninterrupted or secure access to the service, and operation of Horsezone may be interfered with by numerous factors outside of our control. You acknowledge that the Internet can be an unstable and sometimes an insecure marketplace. At times the service may not be available or bids placed at online auctions may not be processed or may not be accepted for reasons beyond our control. In these circumstances we accept no responsibility. Neither the AWHA QLD Branch or Horsezone will post a bid on your behalf.

- 10. We cannot guarantee that we will notice or be able to prevent any illegal or inappropriate use of the Horsezone website. Under no circumstances can you seek compensation from any parties involved in the organisation of this auction.
- 11. You agree that the service is non-refundable, is **payable by COB 05 Sep 14** and that no service or semen can be sold or given to any other person/s. You understand and agree that failure to pay for the stallion service within the specified time frame forfeits your rights to the stallion service which will then be offered to the next highest bidder.
- 12. If you are the successful bidder you will be contacted by the AWHA QLD Branch Publicity Officer advising you of your winning bid. Once your payment has been processed for the stallion service, you will again be contacted by the AWHA QLD Branch Publicity Officer. From here, you are to make direct contact with the stallion owner/frozen semen distributor to arrange to create a contract between yourself and the stallion owner/frozen semen distributor. Please note: payment must be made in full prior to any service or semen exchanges.


