Registrar's news.

Hey everyone, I have spoken to a couple of our classifiers who have told me that they are willing for me to drag them around the countryside! So in the not too distant future I will be contacting people who have paid for mare classifications to let you know when we will be on the road. Depending on locations we may have to do this in sections. This will be a trial to see how effective we can be at cleaning up outstanding and new classifications across Victoria and hopefully into Tasmania. As soon as is feasibly possible I will put a list of destinations and dates on the website- if you fall into our path or nearby it would be a great opportunity to get your mares done at the time.

I have been asked to remind you that your mares will probably move (score) better as younger horses, rather than waiting until you have retired them from competition or they are heavily in foal! Eligible mares can be classified after they turn 3. Just a thought.

It would also be great for planning purposes (colt classifications are quite involved) if anyone who has a colt they might be interested in presenting next year could let me know. The Gala Day/Dressage Day is going to be a major event in itself next year so we may not be able to do multiple horses on that evening, it would be good if we had an initial indication of interest so we can look for another venue and time if necessary.





CHANGES IN VICTORIAN Code of Practise FOR THE WELFARE OF HORSES RE BRANDING

The AHIC has highlighted on their website that there is about to be a revision of the Code of Practice for the Welfare of Horses, which is under the Victorian Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act 1986. The final draft has been reached and will soon be presented to the Minister before proceeding to Parliament.

Horses must not be branded using corrosive chemicals or hot irons under the minimum standards to avoid cruelty to animals. It has not passed yet, but those currently hot branding may wish to look at other methods.

The AWHA no longer <u>requires</u> branding as a form of artificial identification, microchips are now accepted and we recommend that you microchip your foals prior to registration.

16 IDENTIFICATION

Minimum Standards

S16.1 Horses must not be branded using corrosive chemicals or hot irons.

S16.2 Microchips must be inserted by a registered veterinary practitioner in accordance with the Domestic Animals Act 1994.

Guidelines

G16.1 Microchipping with animal owner details recorded on a Victorian Government licensed microchip registry, freeze-branding, DNA profiling and blood type profiling are acceptable methods of permanent identification. G16.2 Hoof fire branding is acceptable as a short-term procedure.

G16.3 Horses should be permanently identified as early as management practices will allow, by persons experienced and proficient in performing the procedure.

G16.4 Where horses are kept at unoccupied premises, the contact details of the person in charge of the horse should be clearly displayed.

G 16.5 Horse owners should regularly check that their contact details are correctly recorded with the licensed animal microchip identification registry. This information will be available two days after the horse has been microchipped. G 16.6In accordance with the Domestic Animals Act 1994, microchips must be inserted into the nuchal ligament halfway along the left hand side of the horse's neck.






