KH – Lengthen stride in canter

HM – develop working canter

MXK – Change rein across the diagonal trot at X

Between A & F – develop left lead canter

B – Circle left 20m

BCH – working canter

HK – Lengthen stride in canter

KF – develop working canter

MXK – Change rein across the diagonal showing some lengthen strides

B – 20m circle allowing the horse to stretch forward and downward while maintaining contact

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What's the difference between classification and the national championship classes?

The National Championship classes are open to all ages and genders of AWH Warmbloods. Horses can enter these every year even if they have entered the year before. Think of it like an Australia wide breed show. You will still receive a score sheet and comments from the judge.

Classification on the other hand is for mares 4 years and over who are eligible. A mare can only be classified once in its life. The score a mare receives from classification will determine which studbook she is placed into. Thoroughbred and Anglo Arab mares are also eligible for classification into the Warmblood Foundation Mare studbook. How do I know if my mare is eligible for classification?

Check your mares registration certificate. There will be a stamp on it which reads this mare is eligible for classification. If you are unsure please contact our Federal Secretary Jade Moody either via phone 0421 493 867 or via email secretary@awha.com.au and she will assist you.

How do I know if my horse is a STUDBOOK OR WPRB class?

Look for the 'Status' on the AWH Registration certificate. If the 'Status' reads Warmblood Performance Registration Book (WPRB) or Warmblood Identification Register (WID) your horse will enter the WPRB/WID classes. All other horses will be in the Stud Book classes. If your horse is entered registration pending, please contact the Federal Registrar via email: registrar@awha.com.au to obtain the status of your horse.

How do I know which class my foal is eligible for?

If the Stallion is an Approved/Licensed/IFS Stallion with the AWH and the Mare has been Classified by the AWH, the foal is entered into the STUDBOOK class. All others are entered into the WPRB.

Can I get help to prepare my horse?

If you need some help in how to prepare for presentation on the day contact your State Committee who will be able to explain how the event will run and how best to prepare your horse for presentation.

There are instructions included in this document on how to present your horse for both the Led and Ridden Classes.

What requirements are needed on my property to have an open venue or stud stop and to show my horse off well?

With an 'Open Venue' you must be able to:

- Provide washroom facilities to all who attend.
- Provide parking for cars and floats.
- Provide an area in which you can let horses run free without being able to jump out.
- Provide a good surface for any ridden entries (60m x 20m).
- Provide a safe environment for all visiting people and horses.
- Provide Public Liability Insurance OR have participants sign a liability waiver (AWHA can provide waiver if required).
- Complete an AWH Risk Management

Policy checklist (AWHA provided). With your own personal 'Stud Stop', it is

advised that:

- You have an area in which you can let horses run free without being able to jump out.
- Provide an area 60m x 20m which you can ride on in the ridden section if entered.
- You will be bound by any COVID or health restrictions in your individual state.

AWHA LTD 2024 CLASSIFICATION TOUR AND NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

1. Entries may be accepted as valid if received by the closing date of **15th January 2024** for all paperwork and payments.
2. Entries for Foals and Horses that are AWAH Ltd Registration Pending will be accepted at the discretion of the AWAH Ltd Federal Registrar, i.e. all supporting documentation including applications and payment must be submitted prior to close of entry.
3. Entries for Foals and Horses in the Open Classes that are registration pending will be accepted at the discretion of the AWAH Ltd Federal Registrar.
4. No refunds after close of entries without a veterinary or medical certificate. The \$15 admin fee will be retained.
5. Entries must include a copy of the horse/s registration papers or registration application (if applicable). Classes are open to all horses registered with the AWAH Ltd (AWAH Ltd Stud Book, Stud Book Appendix, Warmblood Performance Registration Book (WPRB) (Warmblood Identification (WID) Register), Warmblood Foundation Mare Register (WFM).
6. Handlers and riders who ARE NOT current financial members of the AWAH Ltd shall complete and sign the [AWAH Ltd Non-Member Application / Entry Form Release of Waiver of Liability form](#) and pay \$20 for AWAH Ltd day membership. **The waiver form and associated fee must accompany your entry form. Please include the name of Handlers who are not current financial members of the AWAH Ltd in your entry.**
7. AWAH Ltd Handlers and Riders are to complete and sign the [AWAH Ltd Member Dangerous Activity Acknowledgement form](#). **This acknowledgement form must accompany your entry.**
8. [AWAH Ltd Horse Health Declarations](#) must be **completed and signed ON THE DAY of your Class/es**. Please ensure you bring this with you and hand in to the AWAH Ltd Tour Representative on the day. Please note: **Hendra vaccination IS NOT compulsory.**
9. Entire male horses 3 years of age and over must adhere to Equestrian Australia's [EA Stallion safe practices guidelines](#). No colt or stallion may be presented by anyone under 18 years of age. All entire males 2 years of age and over must be led with a bridle and bit.
10. ASA approved safety helmets must be worn at all times when riding, including during warm-up.
11. All exhibits in ridden classes must be ridden in a snaffle bridle. Use of side saddles and martingales is prohibited. Spurs must comply with EA guidelines.
12. All handlers and riders of exhibits (excluding colts and stallions) must be a minimum of fourteen years of age.
